The school property of the State is worth twenty-seven millions of dollars (\$27,000,000,) and we are expending two million dollars (\$2,000,000) a year to add to it and improve it. The law in the State of New York requires us to raise annually one and one-quarter of a mill tax upon each dollar of valuation of taxable property, for the support of the free schools.
